

Investing in your water future



Allconnex Water is continuing to upgrade the wastewater network in Beenleigh.

This \$6.5 million upgrade includes construction of a 1.1km wastewater pipeline from Spanns Road to Kokoda Street and the modification of two wastewater pump stations in the area.

These initiatives will provide capacity for future growth in the Beenleigh area as well as reduce the potential for wastewater overflows and odours.

Current works involve the installation of the final

section of the new wastewater pipeline along Boundary Street via a micro-tunnelling construction method to minimise disruption to the local community.

Works are scheduled for completion in September 2011.

What to expect

Construction will generally occur between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday, however night activities and 24-hour operations may be required from time to time.

Minor impacts may be experienced, including increased noise levels, dust and odour.

Traffic management will be in place throughout the construction phase, with partial lane closures and truck movements to and from work sites.

Did you know?
