

# Investing in your water future



Allconnex Water is making improvements to the wastewater network with the rehabilitation of 150 metres of gravity main in the vicinity of Cosmos Court, Elanora.

Pipes will be laid underneath footpaths and, in some exceptional circumstances, construction will be carried out on private properties between 19th Avenue and Cosmos Court.

Wherever possible construction will consist of a trenchless technique known as micro-tunneling – used to minimise impacts on properties and council

infrastructure – and an open-trench method.

Works are scheduled for completion in August 2011.

The wastewater main upgrade is necessary to ensure Allconnex provides safe, reliable and high-quality water and wastewater services to our customers.

## What to expect

### Working hours

Works will generally take place between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday.

### Disruptions

Due to the location of sections of the wastewater main, Allconnex will need to access some private properties. Customers who are affected will be notified in advance.

Traffic management will be in place along 19th Avenue and Cosmos Court until works are completed.

## Did you know?

In our first year of operation alone Allconnex has delivered over \$200 million in capital works savings.

There will be at least a further \$260 million in capital works savings for the next four years. This is due to our large economies of scale and by working across three districts.

We will also invest more than \$1.2 billion in infrastructure over the next five years.
