

Investing in your water future



Allconnex Water is upgrading wastewater services as part of the Gold Coast University Hospital development.

The \$3.5 million wastewater project will improve services to the health facility at Southport, scheduled for completion in December 2012.

Works include construction of a new pump station on 'Shark Lane' (just off Musgrave Avenue) and upsizing the sewer gravity main network. Work will be finished at the end of June.

Once completed, the pump station site will be landscaped to blend with the surrounding environment.
