

New Beith Reservoir ahead of schedule



Construction of the new 20-megalitre water reservoir at New Beith in Logan is ahead of schedule and due for completion next month.

Works on this \$14.2 million project by Allconnex Water's Logan Water Alliance will increase water storage capacity to cater for future growth in the south-west Logan region. The area has been identified as a hub for residential and industrial development in the State Government's South East Queensland Regional Plan 2005-2026.

The reservoir will start supplying water as residential developments in Greater Flagstone come online.

Allconnex Water will continue to provide high-quality water and wastewater services to Logan customers until Logan City Council resumes delivery of services from 1 July 2012.

Logan water and wastewater accounts arriving this week will include a longer-than-usual water consumption period.
