

Point Lookout Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade project



Allconnex Water is upgrading the Point Lookout Wastewater Treatment Plant on North Stradbroke Island.

Works include the construction of new effluent filtration and diffusion systems which will help increase the capacity to treat wastewater and improve the quality of treated wastewater (effluent) released from the plant.

Allconnex is also rolling out an education program for Point

Lookout accommodation providers to help them communicate the importance of water efficiency to guests.

The Point Lookout Wastewater Treatment Plant upgrade is scheduled for completion in December 2011.

Infrastructure is continually upgraded across the Allconnex network, so that we can provide high-quality water and wastewater services to customers.

Redland City Council will take back control of water and wastewater services from 1 July 2012.

Allconnex's water and wastewater accounts will continue to be combined with Redland City Council rates notices up to this time.

In 2011-12 Allconnex extended the State Government CPI price cap of 3.6 per cent to all customers, not just residents and small businesses.

However, the State Government's bulk water price has increased 29 per cent in the Redlands contributing to increases in your water consumption charges.
