Logan North water quality project

As part of Allconnex Water's continual monitoring and improvement of the water supply network, phased works will be conducted from early December 2011 to April 2012 in the Logan North area.

Water will be transferred between different reservoirs in Logan North and southern Redlands to allow for cleaning and maintenance of reservoirs and pipes. Temporary and permanent infrastructure will also be constructed as part of this project. These works are part of Allconnex Water's program to ensure a high quality, reliable and resilient water supply for its customers.

Water quality

Water supplied in Logan North during this time will continue to meet the high standards of Australian Drinking Water Guidelines. The water supply network within Logan North will continue to be monitored regularly throughout this period.

Impacts

Customers may notice temporary changes to the taste, odour and appearance of the water during this time.

Timeline of works

Mid-February to April 2012

Water quality improvement works will be undertaken in Kimberley Park, Shailer Park, Cornubia, Carbrook, Tanah Merah and Loganholme.

Late February to April 2012

Water quality improvement works will be undertaken in Springwood, Slacks Creek, Shailer Park, Woodridge, Logan Central, Kingston and Berrinba.

Mid-March to April 2012

Water quality improvement works will be undertaken in Daisy Hill, Priestdale, Rochedale and South Underwood.
