New water network becomes a reality

Logan Village's new \$7 million water network and expanded wastewater network is on target for completion by the middle of next year.

Water pipes have been installed throughout the main commercial and residential areas of Logan Village.

New wastewater pipes have been installed in the industrial precinct of Centenary Place. The final stage of the project has commenced. A new trunk water main is being built in the road reserve on Camp Cable Road and along the western side of Waterford-Tamborine Road between Travis and Stockleigh Roads.

The Allconnex Water project will provide reliable water and wastewater services to residents, businesses and visitors as Logan Village continues to grow. It will also provide a water supply for fire fighting purposes.

Allconnex Water's Chief Executive Officer Kim Wood said delivery of the new networks was progressing well. He thanked local residents for their patience and understanding during the works.

"We're working to minimise disruption to the community and the environment during construction of this important project," said Mr Wood.

"The construction method for installing pipes in most locations is 'open trenching', where the ground is excavated to accommodate sections of pipeline. For the final stage of the project, this requires the removal of some trees and vegetation along Camp Cable Road, Stockleigh Road and Waterford-Tamborine Road.

"We have tried to minimise removal of vegetation where possible.

"When each section of work is complete, we'll reinstate the land and encourage natural regeneration. Replanting and ecosystem rehabilitation is also being undertaken off site to balance the effects of vegetation removal," he said

Mr Wood said Allconnex Water's new infrastructure in Logan Village would support the region's growth well into the future.

"Once construction is complete, property owners in Logan Village can connect to the water supply and wastewater networks," he said.
