New reservoir to cater for growth

Allconnex Water is investing more than \$250,000 to improve its water services at Dunwich with the construction of a new 250,000-litre reservoir.

The facility on Illawong Crescent will help to increase water pressure in the supply network and fire-fighting storage capacity.

A concrete slab has already been poured in preparation for the installation of the reservoir, which is scheduled for completion in August 2011.

Allconnex Chief Operating Officer Paul Heaton says the new reservoir is one of many projects to be undertaken in the Redlands to improve services to customers.

"Allconnex is investing significantly in the Redlands with more than \$50 million estimated to be spent over the next five years on water and wastewater infrastructure," said Mr Heaton.

"The new reservoir at Dunwich will improve the current customer service levels."
