Allconnex presents Quarterly Performance Report

Allconnex Water presented its Quarterly Performance Report for Quarter 3 (January to March 2011) to Gold Coast City Council today (Wednesday 25 May).

General Manager Strategy and Development Andrew Foley said the presentation included updates on budget, major infrastructure works, workplace health and safety and community education.

“Allconnex reported it has identified more than \$200 million in savings in capital costs through innovative solutions,” said Mr Foley.

“At Merrimac West costs for a planned network upgrade will be reduced by \$140 million through identification of an alternative technical solution.

“In addition, savings of more than \$60 million have been identified by Allconnex for the Stapylton-Beenleigh Wastewater Treatment solution.

“This saving is a benefit of Allconnex operating across council boundaries - in this instance across Gold Coast and Logan.”

Meanwhile, improvements being completed at the Elanora Wastewater Treatment Plant will increase the use of recycled water for the plant’s existing and future facilities, reduce power costs and improve odour treatment and reduction.
