Maintaining wastewater systems



Allconnex Water is undertaking maintenance work on sewer access chambers in the Redland area.

We are checking an estimated 22,000 maintenance holes in the area to make sure they are not covered or buried and are suitable for access by employees in an emergency.

It is vital for work crews to have easy and ready access to these chambers so that

What to expect

Disruptions

There are a number of sewer maintenance holes across the region within footpaths, roadways and within private property.

If your property is affected by this program, you will be advised a minimum of 48 hours before any works are planned.

Under no circumstances should anyone other than trained personnel authorised by Allconnex Water enter any sewer access chambers. To do so may risk serious injury or death.
